CYO Audition Requirements

Intermediate Orchestra

1. Two-minute prepared solo piece from standard repertoire, memorization is not required. Orchestral parts or string method books will not count as solo piece (with the exception of Suzuki method books). Students should discuss with their private teacher on the appropriate level of the piece. For reference, the solo should be at a similar level to Suzuki Book 4 or 5 that includes some of the developed knowledge listed below (2).

If the selected piece is longer than two minutes, please play the section that best demonstrate the student's technique and musicality. At the conductors' discretion, students may be asked to play a different section of the piece.

Please provide 2 extra copies of your solo piece for conductors.

- 2. Students are expected to have developed knowledge of the following:
 - Staccato, spiccato, legato, and slurred bowing
 - Introductory double stops
 - Introductory vibrato
 - Introductory shifting (violin/viola: 3rd position; cello/bass: 4th position)
 - Tune the instrument
- 3. Sight-reading will be provided at the audition.
- 4. All scales are to be played with standardized fingerings. Each scale should be prepared at $\downarrow = 60$, two 8th notes slurred per bow (use whole bow per slur and no need to repeat top note)

<u>Violin Scales</u> Two-octave G, A, B-flat, C, and D major scales

<u>Viola Scales</u> Two-octave C, D, E-flat, F, and G major scales

<u>Cello Scales</u> Two-octave C, D, E-flat, F, and G major scales

<u>Bass Scales</u> Two-octave E and F major scales One-octave G, A, and B-flat major scales
